
Antibiotic Use


- 1. Use CENTOR SCORE or FEVER PAIN to assess Sore throats
- 2. Encourage the use of Delayed Antibiotics.
- 3. Use EPS (Electronic Prescribing System) or have another system for patients to collect antibiotics prescriptions at a later date . (70% prescriptions not picked up)
- 4. Share Patient information leaflets
- 5. Be firm, do not give unnecessary antibiotics! Reducing antibiotic prescribing will reduce consultations
- 6. For an acute cough , if you are uncertain if it's a bacterial or viral infection –do a CRP
- 7. Nitrofurantoin covers most E.Coli in UTI.






