Background

- The hospice charity began in 1998 after the death of 11 year old Richard Cooper, who died peacefully at home.
- Bluebell Wood opened its doors in 2008.
- Currently supports around 250 families.
- Costs over £4 million a year, of which only 10% is from statutory government funding.



Who do we help?

- Cares for children and young adults with life shortening conditions and complex medical needs.
- South Yorkshire, North Nottinghamshire, North Derbyshire and North Lincolnshire.
- Care provided up until the age of 25.

- Symptom Management



- Give parents a chance to spend time with their child.
- Access practical help and support from hospice team.

Medical input

- Led by Dr Anton Mayer
- Assist with symptom control, assisting with drawing up the LOTA, supporting care at home.
- End of life care in hospice or home
- 2 weekly visits at home/clinic
- On call service
- Assist with transition process
- 2 Non medical prescribers

Referral

- New referrals accepted up until 19th birthday.
- Panel meeting.
- Referrals to hospice for short breaks can be made by parents, carers, paediatrician, GP, Health Visitor, CCN's, Social worker and school.
- Referral to medical team is by medical/surgical team only.
