Tips to improve HIV testing rates

A few quick facts:

- HIV is commoner than you might think 11 practices in Barnsley have populations with rates > 2
 per 1000, the level at which NICE recommends universal testing of all new adult registrants with
 primary care
- HIV is treatable and if an individual is fully supressed on treatment they cannot transmit the virus to another person
- Treatment is usually one or two tablets once a day, and there are few side effect
- The biggest cause of death directly related to HIV is late diagnosis and many of these individuals have had multiple missed opportunities for testing.



Public Health England 2017 confirm:

Undetectable = un-transmittable

Don't be put off offering HIV testing – if Prince Harry can promote testing so can you!

- Issue patient leaflets at reception so patients can consider testing before the consultation
- ❖ Make HIV testing part of routine care
- Add HIV to relevant test request sets on ICE
