## STH referral pathway for adult patients with query Familial Hypercholesterolaemia (FH)

Suspect familial hypercholesterolaemia (FH) as a possible BOX 1 diagnosis in adults with: Total cholesterol >7.5 mmol/L An event is defined as angina, acute coronary • and personal or family history of premature coronary syndrome, myocardial infarction, need for heart disease (an event before 60 years in an index or firstcoronary artery bypass grafting, need for degree relative) See BOX 1 percutaneous coronary intervention or definite coronary artery disease on coronary angiography Confirm LDL >4.9 mmol/L by checking fasting Exclude secondary causes: Secondary causes of high extended lipid profile on 2 occasions, approx. 2 cholesterol include uncontrolled hypothyroidism, weeks apart cholestatic liver disease and nephrotic syndrome. Uncontrolled diabetes and alcohol excess are also associated with raised triglycerides. Tendon xanthoma?
