## Lung Cancer Screening

- For 55-74 yr olds who have ever smoked
- A low dose CT scan for those at high risk determined by a telephone questionnaire with a nurse
- Doncaster selected as one of 10 pilot areas due to high lung cancer and smoking rates, started in 2021. Barnsley then started in January 2023
