  - Capacity to extend to 7 WTE CPs and 2 WTE Technicians
- 3. Appointment of 8 Physician Associates
- 4. 24 WTE Care Co-Ordinators
- 5. 12 WTE Health and Wellbeing Coaches

## **Care Co-Ordinators**



- Central point of contact for Care Homes to facilitate an effective working relationship between the Lead GP and the care home
- Organise care homes MDT meetings where all members of the core MDT team will be invited
- Contact Care Home(s), RightCare and core members of the MDT to collate referral forms and pull together a list of patients who require review and share these with the MDT
- Will contribute to SMRs and Social Prescribing service

# Health and Wellbeing Coaches



- Practice based and allocated on patient list size
- Work as part of the care homes MDT to support personalised care planning and the management of LTC patients
- Guide and support people with LTCs to reach selfidentified health and wellbeing goals
- Promote the benefits of improving health through smoking cessation, reducing weight and increasing physical activity.

# **Physician Associates**



- 8 PAs appointed to work across Practices in Barnsley starting on 9<sup>th</sup> November
- Patient facing role based in Practice, that will provide a degree of backfill for GPs/ANPs working on Care Homes and other elements
- Will require mentoring in GP support in the short to medium term, long term benefit
