### WHAT IS THE EDUCATIONAL FELLOWSHIP?

A 12 month fellowship in collaboration with the Yorkshire and Humber GP school designed to empower and equip doctors, clinicians and managers with the skills and knowledge to drive innovation and excellence in primary care education. With a focus on developing leaders who can create, enhance, and sustain educational networks across practices and primary care networks (PCNs), fostering collaboration and continuous improvement in medical and clinical training and practice.

### WHO IS IT FOR?

- ✓ GP, Clinical professional or manager
- ✓ Working in a GP practice or Primary Care Network In Yorkshire & Humber
- ✓ Demonstrated leadership potential and a commitment to advancing education and training
- ✓ Ideally within the first five years of professional practice and with two years post qualification /post CCT experience within a general practice environment.

 A bursary will be paid to your practice towards your time for 2 sessions a week protected study/professional development time for 12 months of the fellowship programme.

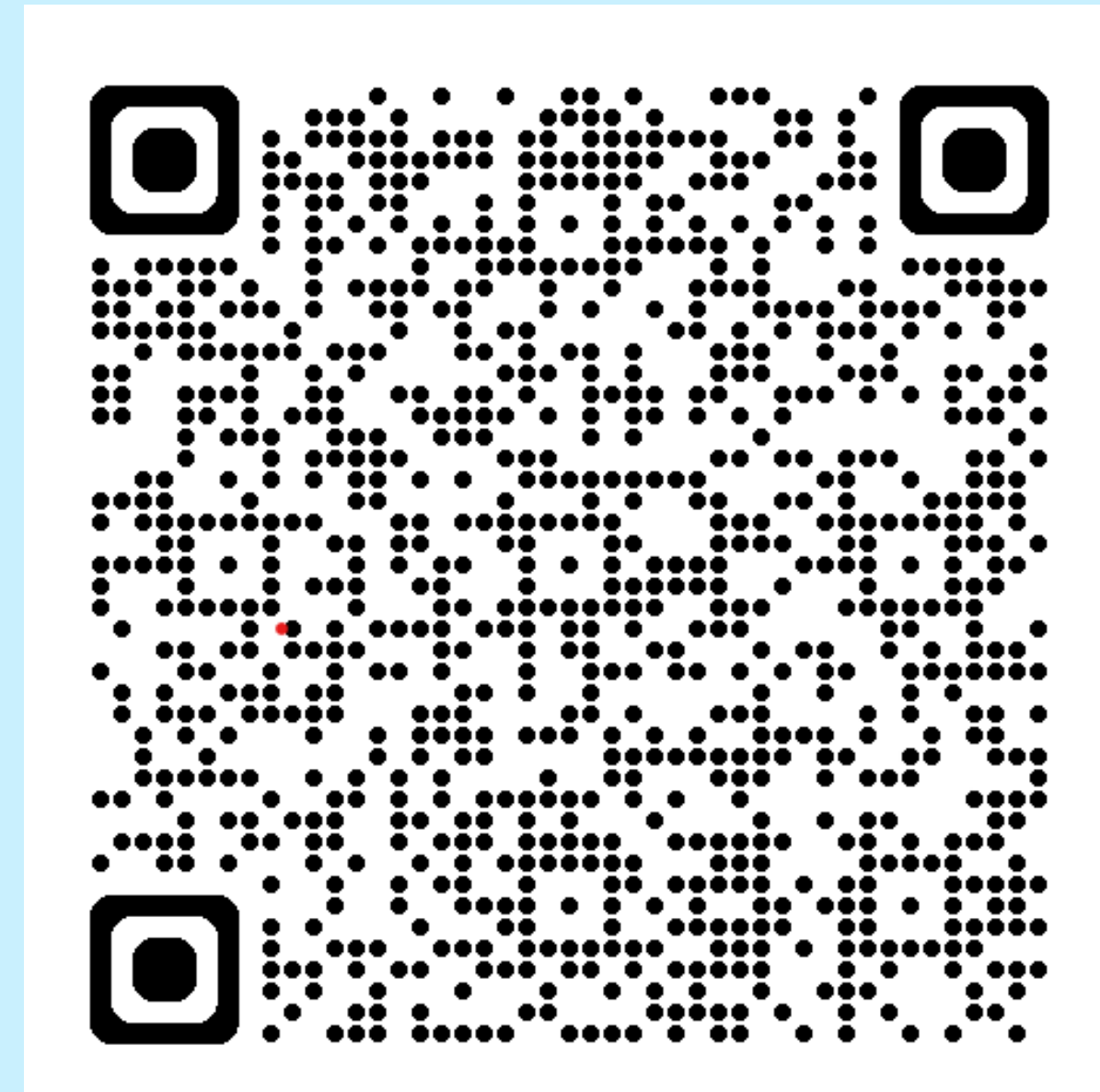

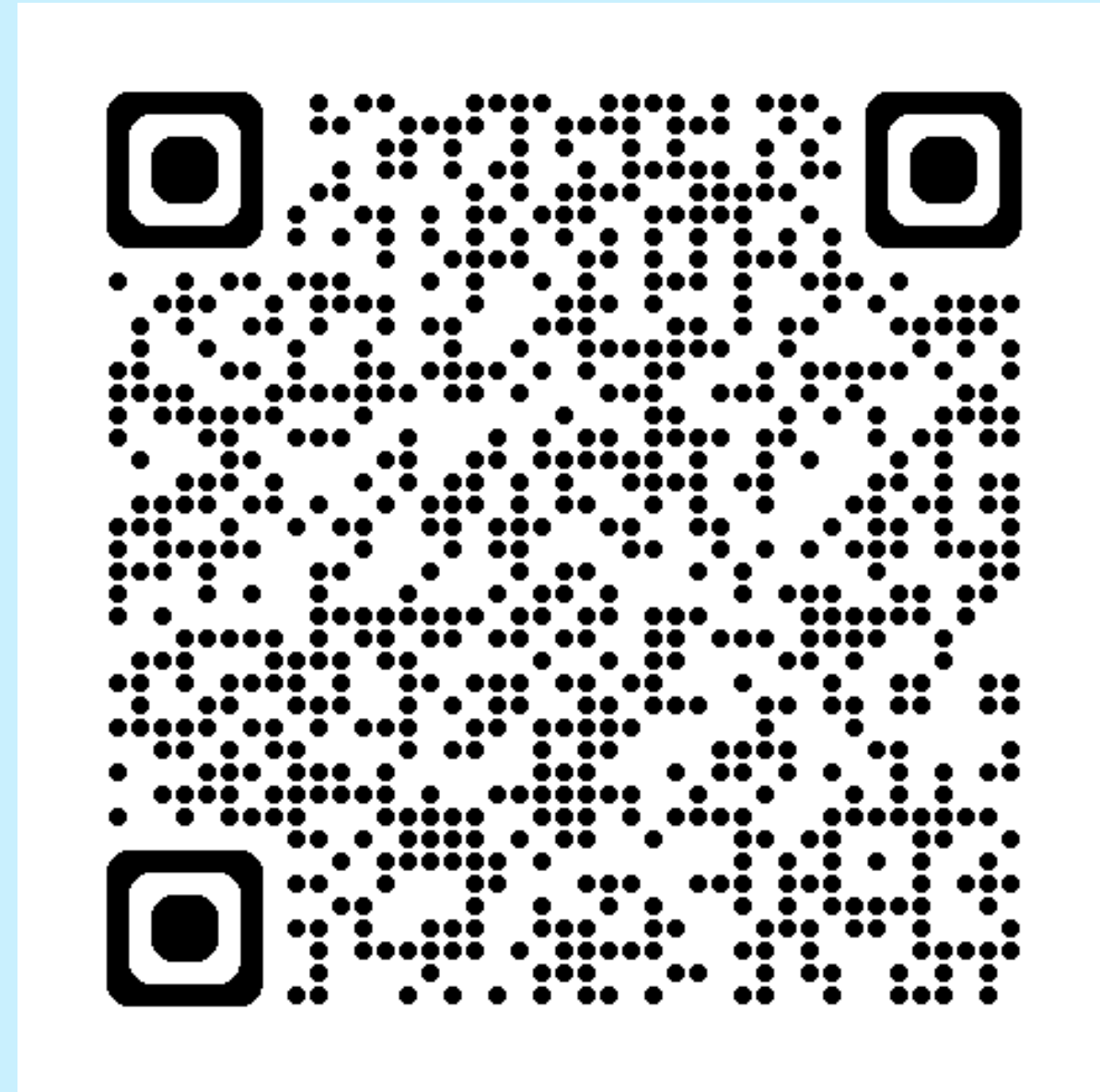

# ACP training via apprenticeship route



- Funding for new Level 7 apprenticeships for over 22s is being removed from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026
- It will no longer be possible to fund ACP training through apprenticeship levy after this date
- Trainee ACPs already on programme will NOT be affected
- Future funding for ACP training not yet confirmed – may be fees funded but will probably be more limited

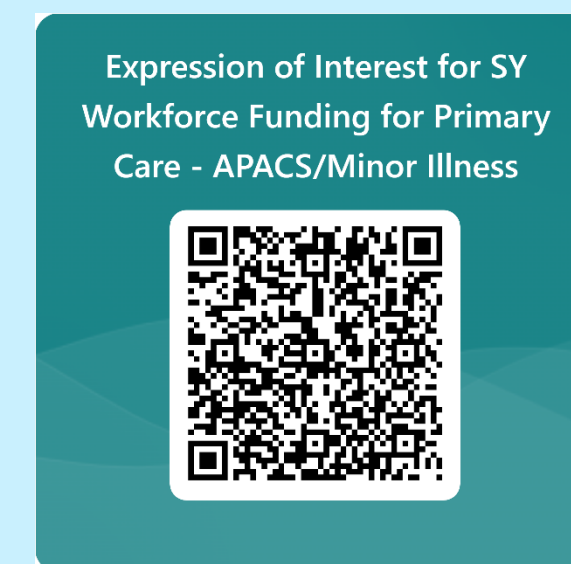
# Funding for NMP training for primary care

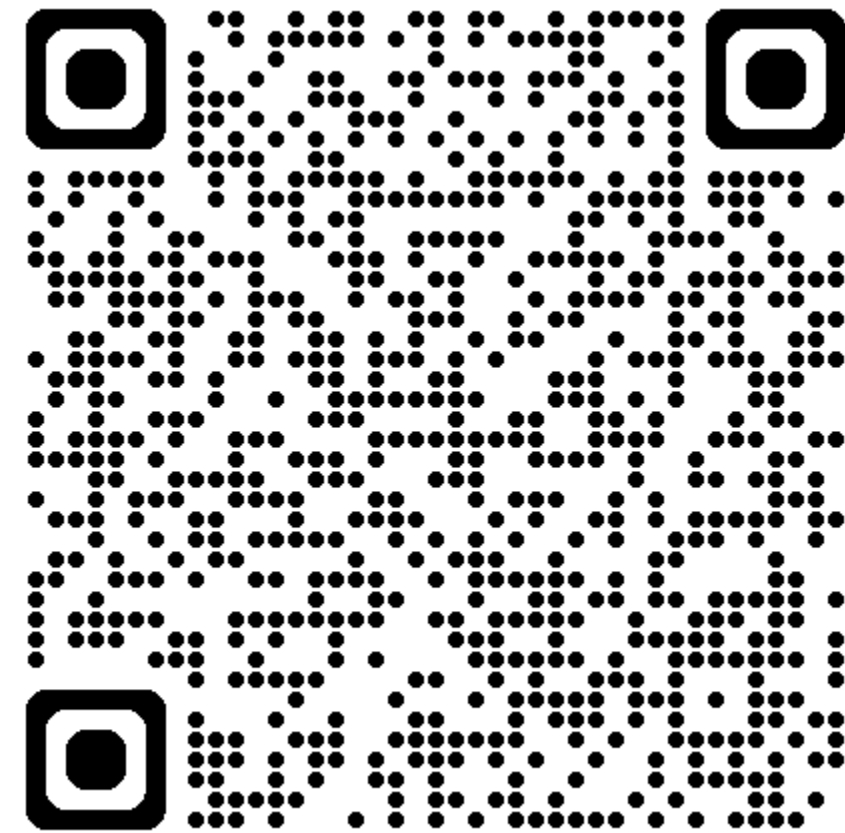

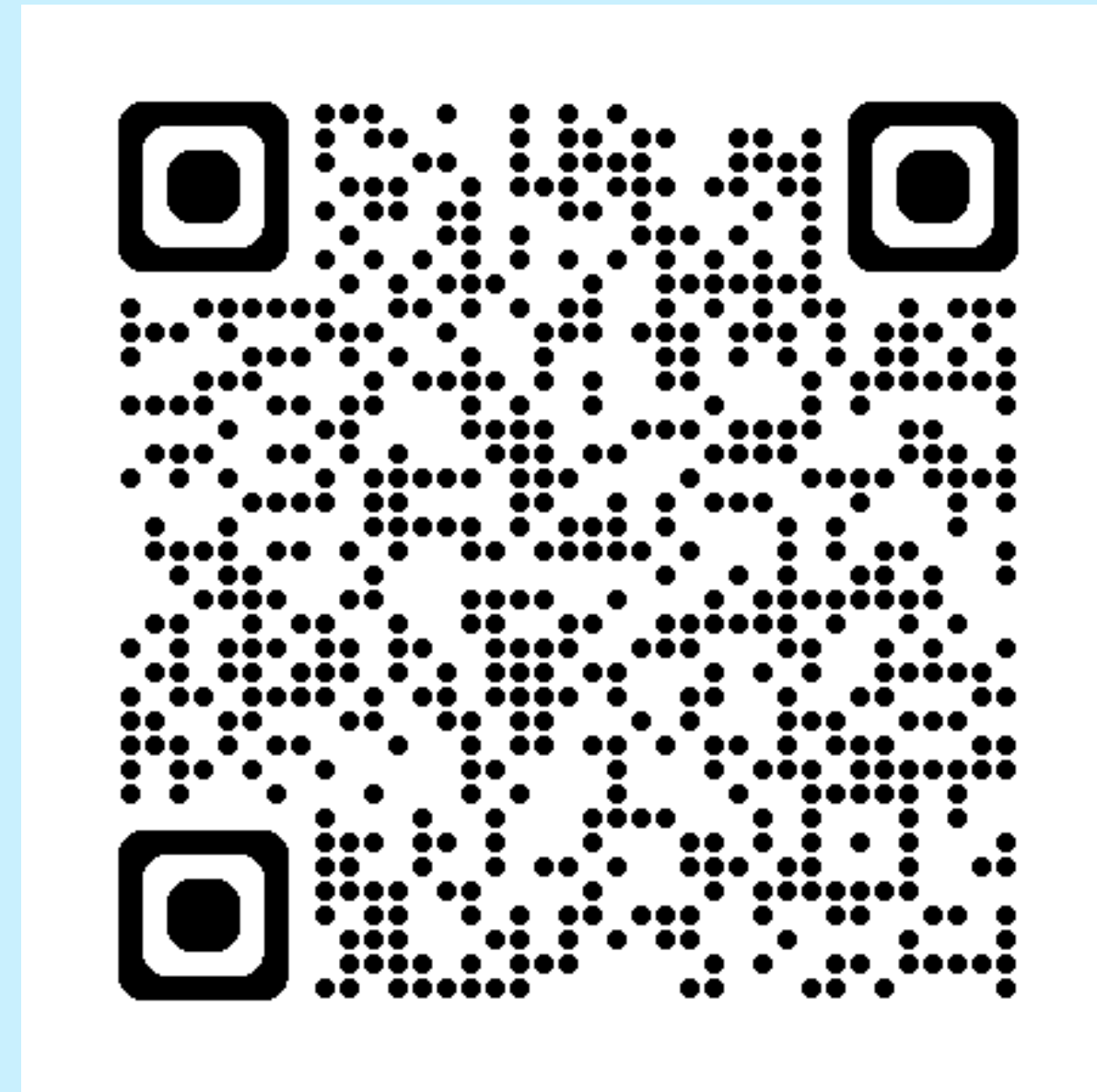
