




GP Pathway for foot and ankle soft tissue lumps and bumps Lesion Summary Table

Type of lesion	Choice of Treatment
Ganglion Plantar fibroma	 Leave if not causing pain If causing accommodation issues i.e. painful to walk on-refer to foot & ankle for orthotic management This can be treated either by aspiration in the practice or by referral to a surgical provider Refer if rapid enlargement (red flag) Leave if not causing pain (red flag) If causing accommodation issues i.e. painful to walk on-refer to foot & ankle for orthotic management Removal is recommended-they return and can become more aggressive Refer if rapid enlargement (red flag)
Lipoma	 Leave if not causing pain Refer if rapid enlargement (red flag) If causing accommodation issues i.e. painful to walk on-refer to foot & ankle for orthotic management If patient wants it removed-refer to surgical provider
