- **UPDATE:** Although funding for new Level 7 apprenticeships is being removed from 1st January 2026, **NHSE have now confirmed that they will continue to fund ACP training courses after this date**
- **ACP Commissioning Round 25/26 still open**
- ACP course places for Dec 25 (SHU only) still available
- £10,710 per year grant to support with training costs

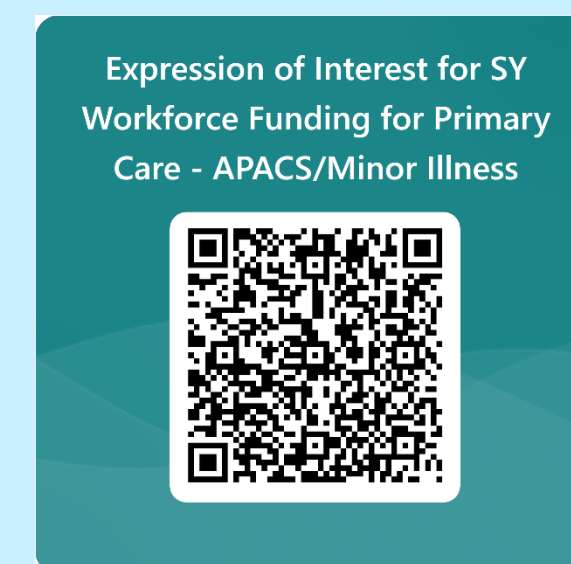
Funding for NMP training for primary care

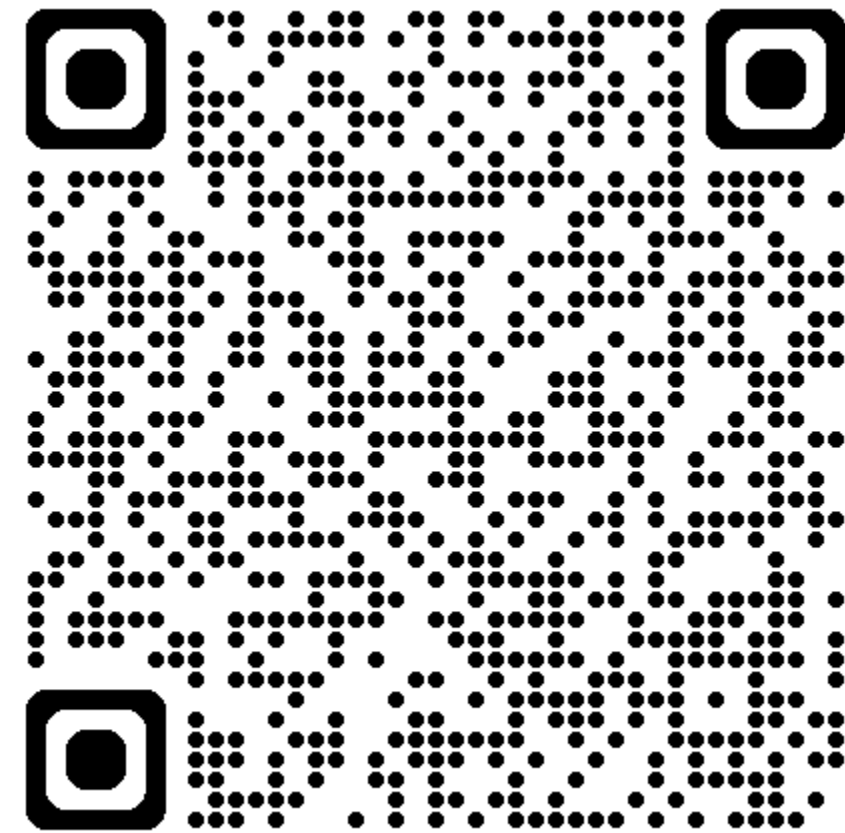
