

ACP training



- UPDATE: Although funding for new Level 7 apprenticeships is being removed from 1st January 2026, NHSE have now confirmed that they will continue to fund ACP training courses after this date
- ACP Commissioning Round 25/26 still open
- ACP course places for Dec 25 (SHU only) still available
- £10,710 per year grant to support with training costs
- Funding applications must come from employers click the QR code for further information
- Deadline is 30th October 2025

Funding for NMP training

- Currently available for Jan 26 starts (Sheffield Hallam only) at Level 6 & Level 7
- Funding is for course fees only (no backfill) so must have employer support & an identified clinical supervisor
- Funding applications must come from employers via the SY Training Hub website NMP page
- Deadline is 12th December 2025





NEW: Funding for ACP modules



- Limited one-off funding for Sheffield Hallam Jan 26 only:
- L7 APACS
- L7 Managing Acute Illness In Primary Care (previously 'Minor Illness')
- L7 Core Principles of Paediatrics In Primary Care
- L7 Managing Clinical Complexities in Primary Care
- Funding is for course fees only (no backfill) so must have employer support/ protected learning time
- Trainees must have a minimum 3 years post-qualification experience, be working towards an ACP qualification & meet the course criteria
- Funding applications must come from employers
