WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE WORRIED ABOUT AN ADULT OR CHILD



- Gather available information to inform your decision/support your concern including talking to other relevant professionals as appropriate.
- Discuss with your safeguarding practice lead or Named/Designated Safeguarding Professional.
- For children: consider the threshold guidance: [Threshold Guidance](#)

- Refer to the Assessment Team on 01226 772423 or out of hours 787789.
- Within 24 hours of telephone discussion complete the record of contact form - [Contact form](#).

- Within one working day: Social Worker and manager will acknowledge receipt of the contact and decide on course of action. Feedback will be provided to referrer.
- Within 72 Hours: if no feedback is received, contact the team for an update.
