PRINCIPLES OF SAFE AND APPROPRIATE HANDLING OF MEDICINES

Your role is important in enabling people to get the maximum benefit from their medication and ensuring their safety

UNDERTAKE TRAINING TO OBTAIN THE NECESSARY KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS.

FOLLOW PROCEDURES:

- ENSURE NECESSARY MEDICINES ARE AVAILABLE.
- STORE MEDICINES SAFELY Do not leave cupboards / trolleys unlocked or unattended.
- GIVE MEDICINES CORRECTLY (6 R'S).
- KEEP APPROPRIATE RECORDS.
- DISPOSE OF UNWANTED MEDICINES SAFELY.

ENSURE ACCESS TO A PHARMACIST'S ADVICE.

NEVER USE MEDICINES TO CONTROL BEHAVIOUR.

CONSIDER PEOPLE'S CHOICE, DIGNITY AND PRIVACY.
