What is QIPP?

- A process to support clinical teams and organisations to improve the quality of care whilst making efficiency savings that can be reinvested back in to the NHS.
- This process will be completed through a programme based on the four concepts in its title.

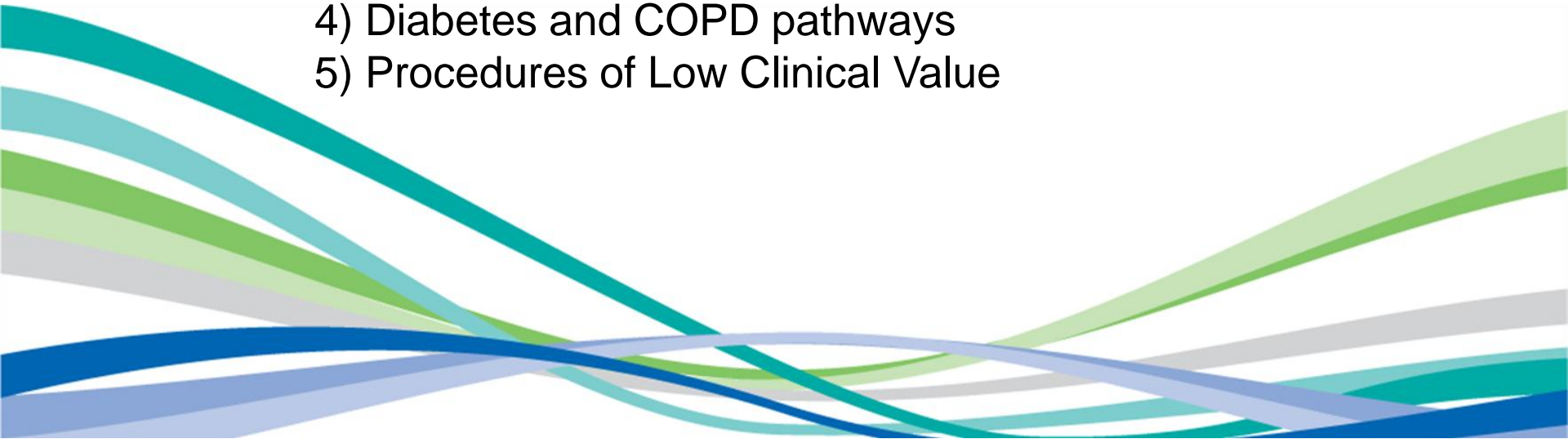


Barnsley CCG context 2015/2016

- Barnsley CCG are required to make further QIPP savings of £4.9 Million in 2015-16, as part of the approved Financial Plan.

This year the CCG's five areas of QIPP focus are:

- 1) Consistency in Performance and Delivery
- 2) Medicines Management
- 3) RightCare Barnsley
- 4) Diabetes and COPD pathways
- 5) Procedures of Low Clinical Value

2015 – 2016

- Consistency in Performance and Delivery

Building on the positive aspects of the previous work.

- ✓ GP forums – Develop a website for Barnsley CCG (possibly through the BEST website)
- ✓ Joint injections in primary care
- ✓ Choose and Book Advisory Service
- ✓ Map of Medicines
- ✓ Orthopaedics –
 - ✓ Hip and Knee Replacements - the cost of these procedures in 2014/15 was **£5,918,988**
- ✓ Review Minor operations in GP surgeries.



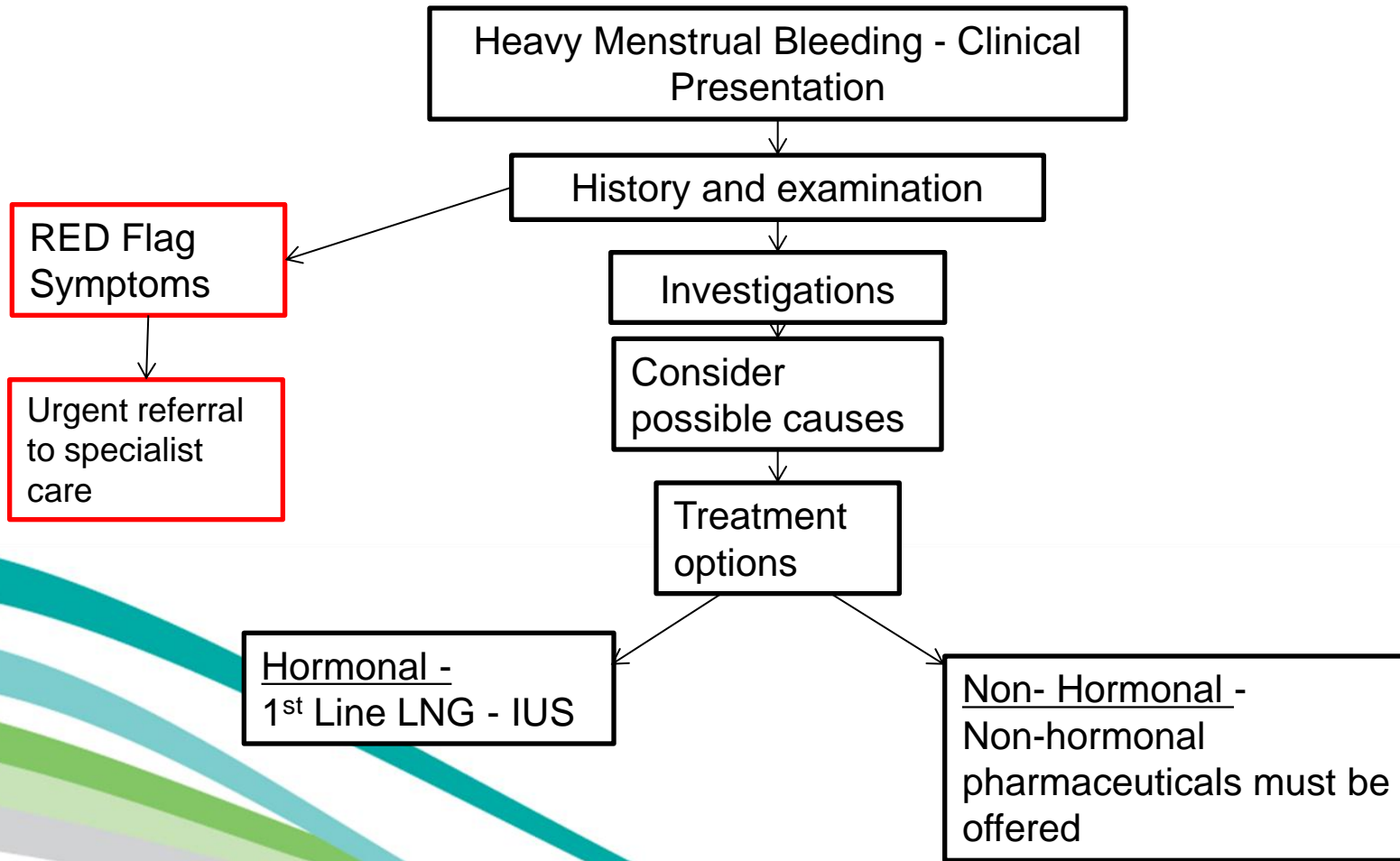
- Procedures of Low Clinical Value – Women's Health

2014/ 15 data coded as:

- ✓ Hysterectomy – **202** operations costing **£619,718** an increase of **34.3%** since 2009/10
 - ✓ Abdominal Excision of Uterus -**10** operations costing **£34,599** an increase of **211.4%** since 2009/10
 - ✓ Vaginal Excision of Uterus – **22** operations costing **£58,951** a decrease of **£-42.3%** since 2009/10

- BHNFT out patient departments fitted **41** coils for heavy menstrual bleeding.
 - In addition to coils fitted in primary care
 - In addition to patients who have been sent to Spectrum
 - In addition to coils fitted by the CASH clinics

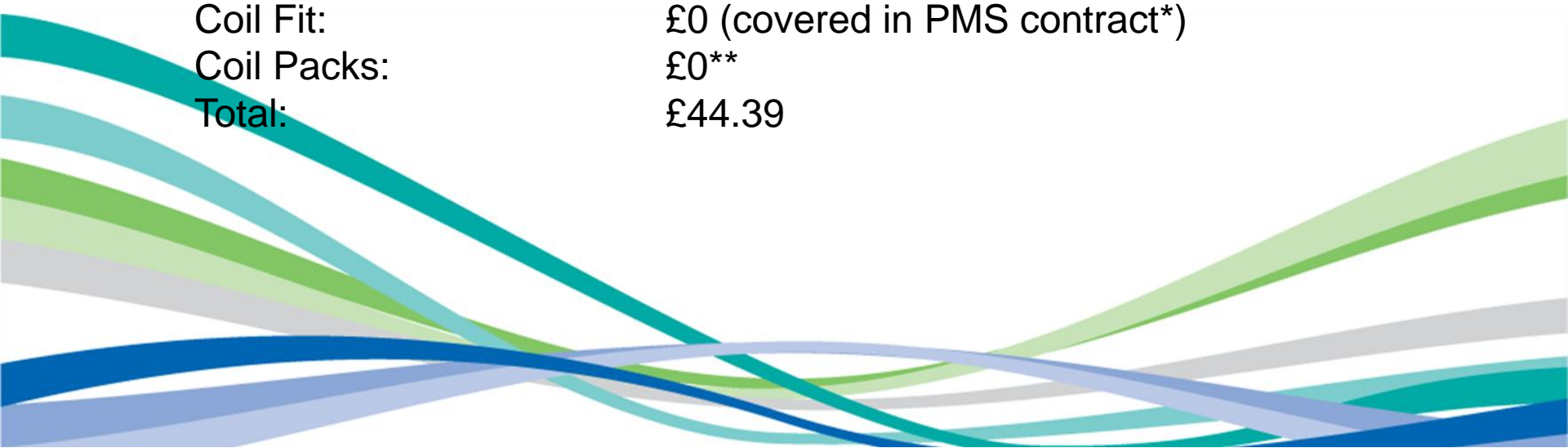

How much does it cost to fit a coil in Secondary Care?

Ultrasound:	£44.39
Coil Fit:	£130.07
Total:	£174.46

How much does it cost to fit a coil in Primary Care?

DA Ultrasound:	£44.39
Coil Fit:	£0 (covered in PMS contract*)
Coil Packs:	£0**
Total:	£44.39

- This is a whole CCG membership approach.
- E-mails have been sent to practices to ask for suggestions



Barnsley CCG 2015 and beyond

- Examples of suggestions received:
 - **Coeliac patients receiving biscuit/ cakes on prescription**
 - Issues with prescribing for transgender patients.
 - Carpel tunnel injections prior to referral for surgery
 - Ophthalmology Triage by GPSI for all referrals (like MSK) to streamline referrals and reduce inappropriate referrals to secondary care
 - Community ENT clinics
 - Setting up Menorrhagia clinic in GP practice & coil insertion in the community. E.g:- community Gynea clinics with specialist input as & when needed. Lead by GPSI


- Examples of suggestions received:
 - Secondary Care spend on prescriptions to use more cost effective drugs



Barnsley CCG 2015 and beyond

- The CCG QIPP meeting explored all of the suggestions in more details.

Example – Coeliac Patients and prescriptions:

- To prescribe gluten free products is very expensive more so that buying them in a retail outlet.
 - NICE have published a points system for these patients
 - The CCG are looking into a personalised budget for gluten free products so patients can buy the products over the counter and not on prescription.
