What is the PCN



- From 1 July 2019, all patients in England should be covered by a primary care network (PCN)
- The NHS long term plan envisages that the networks support improvements in primary care
- Allows primary care to play a larger role in the Integrated Care Systems (ICS)
- Patient populations of 30-50,000
- It is an enhancement to the core GP contract
- Opportunity to bring new roles into Primary Care and extend the Practice Team


