

CYP EHWB Transformation Lead Role

2 year post co-funded by CCG and BMBC Public Health

Background: Peer review visit to Kirklees Council where 'Thriving Kirklees' was being developed identified a gap in Barnsley for a Transformation Lead to provide strategic oversight and leadership across the CYP EHWB pathway. Kirklees were developing a service specification based on a shared philosophy, commitment to i-Thrive and integration of wider systems including; Social care, Early help and Community interventions to establish a collective ownership and shared responsibility for children and young people's emotional health and wellbeing. Whilst we are not currently looking to move to a joint commissioning model, Barnsley are committed to developing an integrated system of Emotional Health and Wellbeing support through the development of services.

Purpose of the Role: To provide a Borough wide strategic leadership role in the design, implementation and integration of children and young people's services to improve emotional health and wellbeing outcomes. The Transformation Lead will support commissioners and providers of children's services to ensure a continuum of service delivery between universal and more specialised services with a focus upon mental and emotional health improvement, prevention of mental health problems and early intervention when problems arise.
