It is known as the 'secret crime' and only a third of victims report fraud. Victims often having feelings of shame, embarrassment and guilt. Particularly the elderly and vulnerable.

Colette will lead an awareness session on gaming, youth gambling-related harms, advertising, mental health and cryptocurrency.
